RECONSTRUCTION OF LONG HILL ROAD**

The Town of Guilford is seeking competitive bids for a contractor to reconstruct Long Hill Road in Guilford, Connecticut. Sealed Bids will be due on Thursday, December 8, 2016 at 02:00 p.m. on the second floor, 31 Park Street, the Office of the First Selectman, at which time they will be opened publicly. Bids received after this date and time will be rejected. Sealed Bid proposals should be labeled with bid number and bid title. Bid specifications may be obtained on the second floor in the Office of the First Selectman, 31 Park Street, Guilford, Connecticut 06437 for a purchase price of \$150.00/set, by check made payable to the Town of Guilford.

Bidders are advised that both the Connecticut Department of Transportation (CDOT) approved Prequalification Application and Update Certification Form for Prequalification must accompany the bid proposal for projects estimated to exceed Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000). Failure to supply them with the bid will result in rejection of the bid. The CDOT Work Classification is "Group No. 6 Road Construction and Rehabilitation: Local Roads & Streets and non-freeways".

A non-mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting among prospective bidders and the Town Engineer will convene at conference room on second floor in the Office of the First Selectman on Thursday, November 17, 2016 at 10:00 a.m., when project details will be discussed and questions answered, which such information will be issued in a subsequent Addendum as appropriate.

Each bidder will be required to submit to the Office of the First Selectman, their original proposal with two (2) copies and a bid bond or cashier's check in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the base bid. Each bidder shall honor the bid price for ninety (90) business days from the date of the bid opening, without modification. Upon award of the bid, the winning bidder shall be bound by the bid proposal price throughout the contract period.

The minimum rates to be paid labor of the various classifications on this project shall be in accordance with current schedule of Prevailing Wages as established by the State of Connecticut, Department of Labor, Wage and Workplace Standards Division; and the Federal wage rates (Davis-Bacon Act) by the US Department of Labor as may be revised 10 days prior to bid opening.

The Town of Guilford reserves the right to reject any or all bids; or to waive defects in same, if it deems such to be in the best interest of the Town. The Town of Guilford is an affirmative action, equal opportunity employer. This contract is subject to State set-aside (**5% DBE**; must be CDOT approved DBE), nondiscrimination and affirmative action requirements.
