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Also, the removal of the existing type AA floodlights is required. These fixtures are to be given to the school facilities department upon removal.

The Work includes the procurement and installation of new building mounted exterior downlights to new electrical boxes mounted in the existing exterior walls of the building. Power to the new box locations is to be fed from the panel indicated and run in concealed fashion above ceilings to the new location..

1.4 USE OF PREMISES

- A. General: Each Contractor shall have full use of areas designated by the Owner for construction operations during construction period. .
- B. Use of Site: Limit use of premises to areas designated by the Owner within the Contract limits indicated. The site will remain in operation as a high school throughout the duration of construction. Do not disturb portions of Project site beyond areas in which the Work is indicated.
- C. Work Hours: Provide construction time schedule three days in advance of arriving on the site to the Principal, Assistant Principal and Chief Custodian. **Schedule work for days when school is not in session. Schedule work on the following days: April 10th-14th, May 12th, June 19th - July 3rd. Work hours on these days are from 6:00am till 4:00pm.** ~~To reserve parking on site, contractor is to set up cones in parking spaces designated by the school administration to students' arrival at 6:30am.~~ Include premium time for starting and adjusting light fixtures during exterior dark conditions

1.5 SPECIFICATION FORMATS AND CONVENTIONS

- A. Specification Format: The Specifications are organized into Divisions and Sections using the 16-division format and CSI/CSC's "MasterFormat" numbering system.
 - 1. Section Identification: The Specifications use Section numbers and titles to help cross-referencing in the Contract Documents. Sections in the Project Manual are in numeric sequence, although the sequence is not consecutive because not all CSI/CSC Section numbers are applicable to this Project. Consult the table of contents at the beginning of the Project Manual to determine numbers and names of Sections in the Contract Documents.
 - 2. The Specifications are divided into Sections for the convenience of the Architect. They are not an indication of subcontract limits or subcontract assignments. The Construction Manager will determine the number of subcontracts and how the Work will be allocated among subcontractors.
 - 3. Division 1: Sections in Division 1 govern the execution of the Work of all Sections in the Specifications.
