The Town of Guilford is seeking competitive bids, through the Guilford High School Building Committee (GHSBC), from qualified contractors to supply and install changes to external lighting at the new Guilford High School. Sealed Bids are due on Thursday November 17, 2016 at 2:00 p.m. at the office of the First Selectman, on the second floor of Town Hall, 31 Park Street, Guilford, CT 06437 at which time they will be opened publicly. Bids received after this date and time will be rejected. Sealed Bid envelopes (including overnight packaging) should be clearly labeled with bid number, bid title and marked "time sensitive". .

Bid plans and specifications may be obtained at the Office of the First Selectman for a non-refundable purchase price of Forty Dollars (\$40.00) and/or by CD format for a non-refundable purchase-price of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00), payable by check made out to the "Town of Guilford".


The minimum rates to be paid labor of the various classifications on this project shall be in accordance with current schedule of Prevailing Wages as established by the State of Connecticut, Department of Labor, Wage and Workplace Standards Division.

A non -mandatory site visit will be held at the New Guilford High School main front entrance on Friday November 4, 2016 at 9:00 a.m.

Each bidder will be required to submit to the Office of the First Selectman, their original proposal with one (1) copy, one (1) electronic copy and a bid bond or cashier's check in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the base bid. Each bidder shall honor the bid price for sixty (60) business days from the date of the bid opening, without modification. Upon award of the bid, the winning bidder shall be bound by the bid proposal price throughout the contract period.

The Town of Guilford reserves the right to reject any or all bids; or to waive defects in same, if it deems such to be in the best interest of the Town. The Town of Guilford is an affirmative action, equal opportunity employer.
